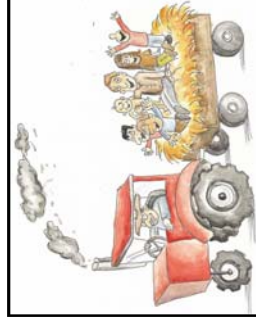


## ARRIVAL—15mins

To start off your visit, we'll gather your class for a class picture and you will enjoy a brief presentation that explains a bit about corn, chickens, and how the maze is made. A few students will be invited to gather eggs from our very own, chicken coop.

## HAYRIDE-30mins

Then your class will be loaded on the hayride and take a tour of our working farm. The students will see crops growing in the field and ongo-



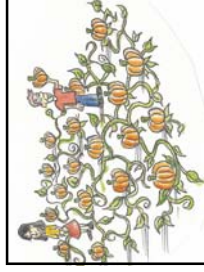
ing farming operations. While on the hayride each student will learn about seeds and plant a seed of their own that they can take home and watch sprout!

## THE CORN MAZE-45mins

Each teacher/chaperone is provided with a corny passport and a map to help guide their group through. As you encounter numbered signs in the maze, stop and answer that numbered question on your passport. If you know the right answer, it will tell you the right way to turn. (Hint...answers are on the back of each passport if needed)

## PUMPKIN PATCH-15mins

During the hayride you will stop by our pumpkin patch and pay a visit to acres of pumpkins and



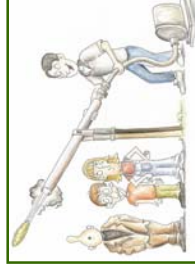
learn how pumpkins are grown. Each class will receive a pumpkin (beginning October 1) to carve. We will display the pumpkin at our farm through the end of October. On October 31st the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Dept will judge the pumpkins and five \$100.00 prizes will be awarded to the winning pumpkins for grades 1 through 5.
